English language.

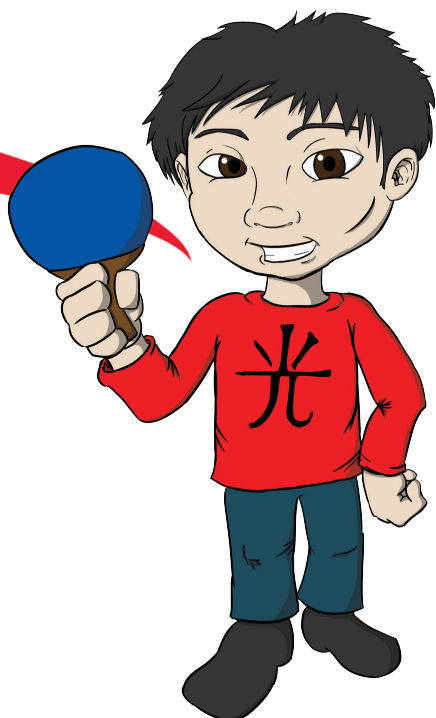

Please watch this short video to learn how to play the game "Who stole the cookie from the cookie jar?"



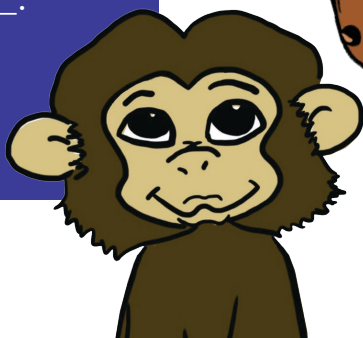
DEVELOPER ACTIVITY:
