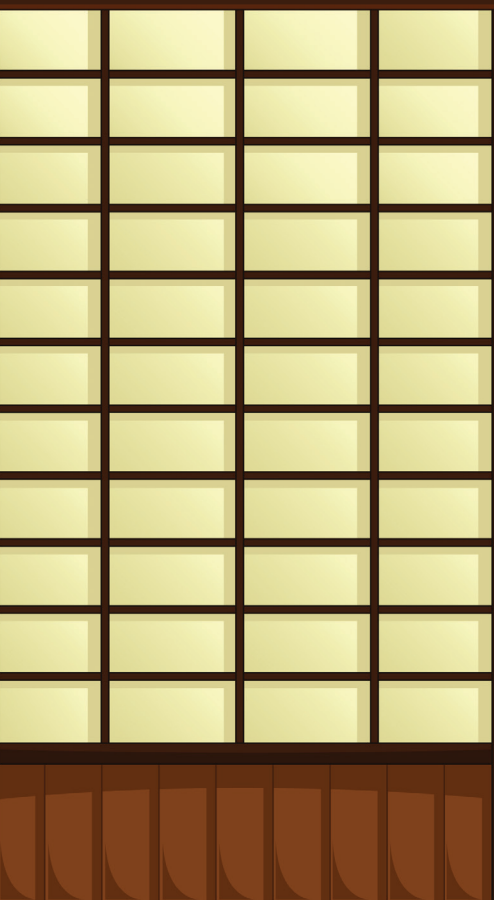

**HELLO, MY NAME IS GUANG!** But I've chosen to go by **LUKE** to help my English speaking friends. My Taiwanese name means "light." Father tells the story of why he chose this name for me.

You see, my parents have not always been citizens of the United States of America. When my father was looking for a place to study engineering, he decided to come to America. He went to a university in Chicago, IL. While there, my father studied very hard and became a very well respected man.

One day he was walking across the campus and saw a group of students gathered around the flagpole with their heads bowed and eyes closed. As he neared them, they finished praying and one young man came toward my father. He introduced himself as Dale Sandrino. He invited my father to a Bible study the following Thursday evening.

My father tells me that he was very uncertain about attending. He had been raised in Taiwan where it is important to worship ancestors. My father felt that he would displease those who had gone before him if he were to attend the meeting. He lived in fear of the spirits, always wanting to please them in all that he did. Even with all of the pressure from the past, he decided to go.

He tells me that he was very impressed by the love and kindness that Dale and the other Christians showed to one another. The thing that amazed him the most, however, was the lack of fear. These believers had placed their trust in a God who helped them to not be afraid of their ancestors or other spirits that might torment them.

My father gave his life to God and I'm so thankful. The light of God's Word dispelled the darkness. He named me Guang to remind him of the amazing light of God's Word. My sister Hua (her English name is Lily) and I still get together with the Sandrinos every year at camp. Alex and Emma are some of our best friends.

We are going to visit their church next week. I can't wait to tell you about the idea we have!

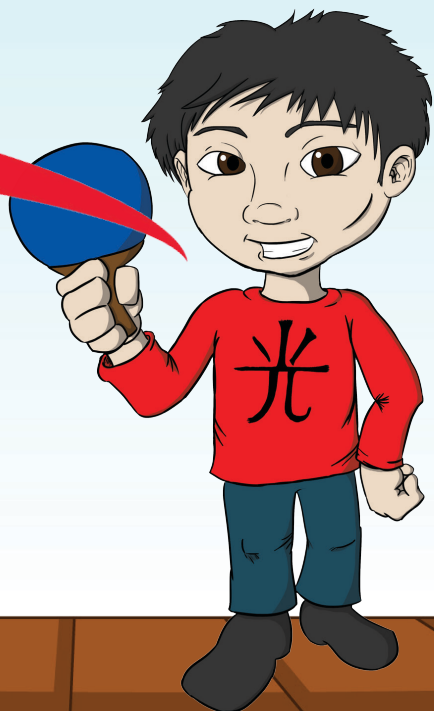
# DO YOU LIKE TO SING?

Once you have gathered friends choose one person to be the eagle, one to be the mother hen and everyone else will be the chicks. The eagle will try to get one of the chicks by tagging them. The mother hen should try to protect the chicks. If a chick is tagged, the game is over the tagged chick becomes the eagle and the eagle becomes the mother hen. Keep playing until everyone has a turn to play.
