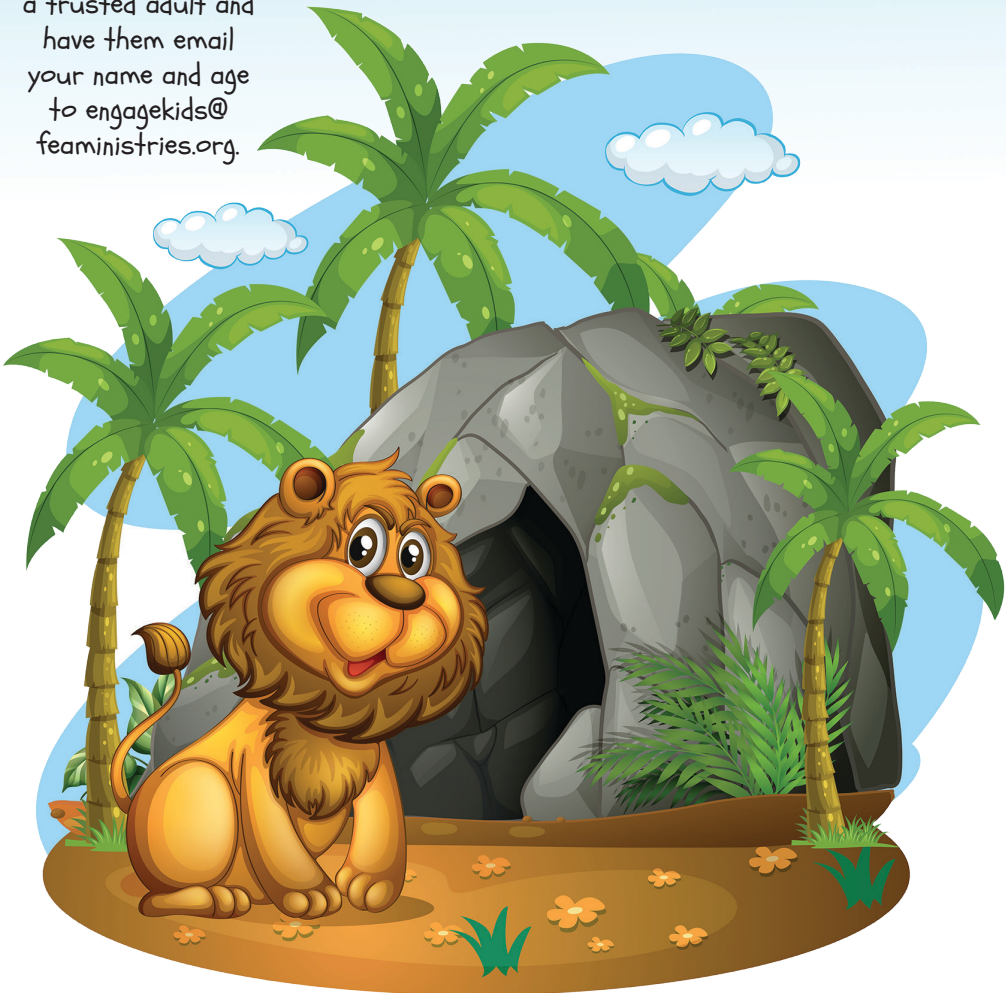

SUNDAY SCHOOL KIDS IN AFRICA

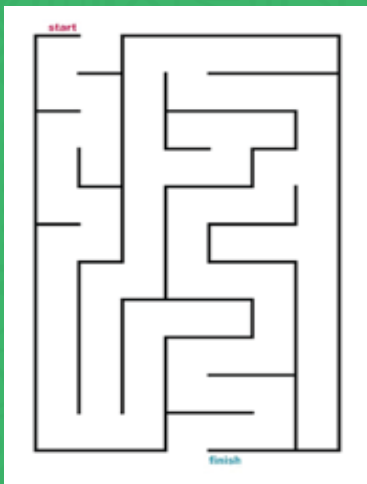
Every Sunday children gather to hear about Jesus. Mrs. Stephanie Gault is their teacher. Sometimes there are many children who come and other times only a few.

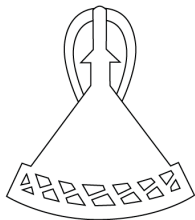
