

PRAYER CHAIN

Have you ever made a paper chain? Well, today we are going to help you make one and give you a fantastic idea of how to use it! This paper chain will have 30 different links—each link representing a day of the month for you to pray for a missionary!

Materials:

- Scissors
- Construction Paper
- Tape/glue

Directions:



- 1. Cut your construction paper into 1 inch wide strips
- 2. Use each strip to form a loop and tape it together
- 3. Take another strip and loop it inside the last loop
- 4. Continue this until you get 30 links
- 5. Hang it up in your room and pray everyday!


