

BROTHER. He has been able to go to Lesotho, Africa, to work with his sister and brother-in-law on several SHORT MISSIONS TRIPS. Here is an INTERVIEW where he tells us what this EXPERIENCE was like for him.



I have traveled to several places in Africa. Some of them were **LESOTHO**, NAMIBIA, ZAMBIA, and SOUTH AFRICA.

QUESTION 2: WHAT WERE SOME BIG DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE WAY PEOPLE LIVE IN LESOTHO COMPARED TO THE WAY PEOPLE LIVE IN AMERICAS

One of the biggest differences I saw was when a person accepts Jesus as his Savior, HE IS OFTEN (AST AWAY FROM HIS FAMILY. Heathen families will completely cut off a family member who becomes a Christian, and they will not associate with him. THE SA(RIFICE OF ASKING JESUS INTO YOUR HEART IS MUCH GREATER THERE THAN IT IS IN MANY (ASES HERE IN AMERICA.

QUESTION 3: WHAT KIND OF FOOD DID YOU GET TO EAT DURING YOUR STAY IN LESOTHOS

We ate a corn meal mush for almost every meal. They often put gravy over top of it and eat it with cabbage. While I was traveling in Zambia, I stopped to get a snack called **BILTONG**. Biltong is similar to our beef jerky; however, it's not made of beef. It is made of zebra meat or even giraffe meat as well. Doesn't giraffe jerky sound appetizing?

QUESTION 4: WHAT WAS THE BEST AND MOST EFFECTIVE WAY OF TEACHING THE GOSPEL TO THE PEOPLE THERES

MANY OF THE PEOPLE DO NOT HAVE BIBLES. I traveled with a Bible distribution team, and we would see older people hold their very own Bible for the first time. They would hug their new Bibles and thank us over and over again. GETTING GOD'S WORD OUT TO THESE PEOPLE IS A HUGE NEED! They desperately need the Word of God.

QUESTION 5: WHAT LIFE LESSON DID YOU LEARN FROM YOUR SHORT MISSION TRIPS TO AFRICAS

I learned that there is a world desperately in need of the gospel. Sometimes it is overwhelming to see how much work needs to be done, but God reminded me that He is not calling me to fix the world. GOD IS ASKING ME TO BE FAITHFUL IN DOING MY PART TO SPREAD THE GOSPEL.



AMAZING AFRICAN ANIMALS!



- 1. HYENAS make noises similar to the sounds of human laughter. These sounds can even help humans determine the age of the hyena.
- A female hyena is much more aggressive and muscular than a male hyena.
- MEERKATS work in groups. They hunt and guard in groups. In a sense, they have their own gangs or clans.
- 2. Humans can recognize the voices of friends and family. Meerkats can do this as well. Each meerkat knows all of its friends by their voices!





- 1. GAZELLES live in the hot, dry deserts of Africa.
- 2. To stay hydrated, they shrink their heart and liver! Breathing can use up a lot of water in their bodies. Smaller hearts and tinier livers require less oxygen and thus less water. There isn't much liquid in the desert!
