To be a missionary, And be God's shining light.

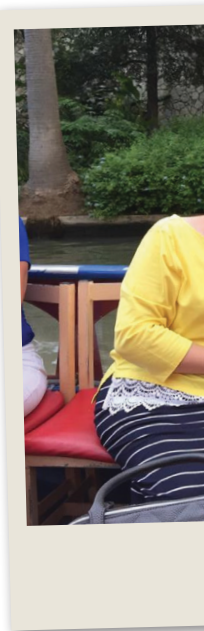
