"Go make your bed." "Come wash the dishes." "Be sure to take out the trash." These may be things you have heard your parents say often. They tell you to do chores to teach you responsibility.

Responsibility is a lesson everyone has to learn. Did you know missionaries not only share the gospel, but they also teach others how to be responsible?

In the country of Honduras the Kuhns and Cressmans reach out to the Honduran people, especially those who are hungry and poor. But they do not just give them a plate of food or money to buy necessities. They help the Hondurans by teaching them responsibility!

The Kuhns and Cressmans work with the local people to start small businesses such as the Coco River Ranch or pig farms. The ranch is a place where cattle are raised to be sold for money or to be butchered for food. This is the purpose of the pig farm too!

The ranches and the pig farms are ways the Honduran people can provide food and money for themselves so that they will not always rely on the missionaries to live.

## The Responsibility Ability

Responsibility is an important lesson everyone has to learn! Our goal in missions is to help local works become self supporting. The Hondurans run a ranch and a pig farm. They also sell water from the well on the pig farm to villagers. Our churches are learning responsibility.
