




They cleaned out a bedroom in the mission house and put in rickety tables and a chalkboard. The first year they only had twelve students. With God's help the school continued to grow and make a lasting difference in student's lives. Today men and women who attended the Wingham's Lighthouse Christian Academy are working in government positions and serving as leaders in various churches. One boy in particular named Junior Forbes went to the school as a little guy. Today he is a church leader in the islands and is continuing to spread the gospel.

The villagers in the Turks and Caicos Islands had a need—Christian education. God supplied the Wighams to fulfill that need, even though they did not feel qualified or prepared to do so.


God wants to use YOU in His plan to spread the gospel. In fact God WILL use you if you give yourself to Him.

Only a little farther to run, and they would be at the truck! Hopefully, no one in the nearby mission house would see what they were up to. Finally reaching the truck, they doused it with kerosene, and with the flick of a match, WHOOSH! The truck went up in a billow of flames. Mission accomplished! Burning high into the air and spreading across the ground, the fire came extremely close to the mission house. But thanks to God's protection the flames did not harm it.

While the boys were proud of their deed, their happiness did not last long. A short time later the police found out who had set fire to the truck! The boys were taken before the district judge. They knew there was not much hope. Legally that judge did not have to show any mercy whatsoever. They had done wrong and would pay the price. However, Mr. Fred Wingham was the supervisor of the mission which owned the truck. Ultimately it was up to him to decide the fate of the boys. To their utter shock and disbelief Mr. Wingham
