


RADIO MINISTRY WORD SEARCH

"Zaoshang hao! Nihao ma*?" Gus asked from his perch beside Miss Jeanne. His greeting of "Good morning! How are you?" was answered with giggles and chatter from the Chinese children as they scooted closer. They were eager to hear the stories Miss Jeanne and her puppet Gus told.

Gus was a great missionary! Children everywhere watched with fascination as Miss Jeanne used Gus to teach about God. But Gus was not Miss Jeanne's only tool for sharing the gospel message. With her special Taiwanese friend Dorothy Hsu ("shee"), Jeanne made many trips to China. These trips were sometimes dangerous. The Chinese government did not like their people meeting to learn about God. So the Chinese Christians had to meet in secret. During their visits Jeanne and Dorothy would encourage the secret church members and provide helpful teaching.


Trips to China were not always possible, so Jeanne and Dorothy found another way to continue their ministry.

A simple short-wave radio got them started, and for nineteen years Jeanne and Dorothy broadcast the gospel and biblical principles from one end of China to the other. God provided the money for this project and blessed their efforts to reach the hearts of the Chinese. Sometimes people they met recognized their voices from the radio programs. Many wrote letters to Jeanne and Dorothy, telling stories of how much the radio broadcasts meant to them.

God protected Jeanne and Dorothy on their trips to China. One time Jeanne got sick. Although that might not seem like a blessing, it was. That same day a man visited a Bible study Dorothy was hosting. Because Jeanne was sick, she could not meet the man. It was later determined that if she had, serious trouble might have been the result. The man was likely a spy! Jeanne was so thankful to God for protecting her in this situation and many others throughout her ministry.
