## Dear Friends,

Greetings in the lovely Name of our Lord Jesus! I'm so thankful for His faithfulness, His tender care, His compassion, His continual guidance in our lives! I'm grateful for the privilege of working with Him in the Harvest fields of this world....

Haiti remains a country in much turmoil and instability with no elected government, the capitol city (Port-au-Prince) overrun by violent

gangs, costs of everything skyrocketing, poverty and starvation levels increasing dramatically. Because of this instability, schools all over the country have missed many days, even months of functioning this past year. Many hospitals and clinics have closed. It has become difficult to get fuel, causing organizations that depend on generators for electricity to have to shut down their operations. Things are dark and difficult, with no solution in sight.



But, even in the darkness, God is working! He has not forgotten His children there. They are continuing to cry out to Him for help in the midst of trouble and are finding Him faithful. I was able to be in Haiti for almost a week over Memorial Day weekend. Frank Vaughn, our Haiti Field Director, was able to be there also. On our first day, we met with our National Committee, which is made up of 5 of our pastors. Each one had encouraging reports from their churches and districts about how the Lord is helping their people. There was no discouragement there! Please do remember our nine churches and pastors, that they will keep encouraged in the Lord and be a bright light in the darkness surrounding them.

On Saturday morning, I had a Bible study with our orphans and the director's children. They have all grown up so much! Some are now in college, some in high school, and three in elementary school (including the director's youngest boy). Our time together was precious as we read and discussed the words of Jesus in Matthew 5-7, ending our time with singing and prayer. That evening, we had a special meal and a party together - something they all look forward to when we are there, with lots of laughter and fun.

On Sunday, after the morning service, I met with some of the boys individually. As we talked and prayed together, the Lord's presence was with us. The first boy (Perside) asked forgiveness for some wrongdoing and told me that he had asked God's forgiveness the night before.
