## Dear Friends and Faithful Supporters:

Greetings once again from warm, sunny Honduras! We hope you are enjoying the ice and snow, but we must admit that is something from the States we do not miss very often.

We began 2024 with our annual youth camp. The theme was "Breaking the Cycle," and Erick Vázquez preached how God can truly break the cycles of sin present in our

lives and in our families. The testimonies we have heard, especially from some of our young men, about how God used the services as a turning point in their lives are so encouraging. The hold of sin in families is strong, but God is working in our teens' hearts! While it is exciting to work with all ages, it is especially wonderful to see teens who want to make a difference in the kingdom and to have families that break the cycle of sin.



Having Esther's mother, sister, and niece visit us in January was an incredible blessing. We loved seeing their perspectives of cultural differences that have often become norms for us. It was also so fun to watch my niece become friends with a local pastor's daughter and connect with the children in our church.

A highlight of the month of February was beginning our education program. For this year it will include two parts: transportation to the local school and an afterschool program two days a week. Some of the children are heading off to school for their first time, while others restart after only attending one or two years. Many who have attended in the past are very behind, and we look forward to helping them make up for lost time.

One child especially dear to our hearts is a young boy named Yeison (Jason). He has a heartbreaking past of abuse and neglect and is currently an orphan by all accounts. We took Yeison to our local thrift store to purchase shoes for school and home. After a little searching, he was so disappointed that we were not able to find any tennis shoes for him. However, in the last section he excitedly pulled out a little pair he recognized as being the perfect size for him. In his eagerness he accidentally dropped the shoes on the ground. A look I can only describe as pure delight crossed his face. "Ester, Ester! They have lights!" I firmly believe God placed a special pair of tennis shoes with lights in that store just for Yeison to let him know how loved he is. In all our years of ministry we have never met a child quite like him who is so visibly hungry for love. Please help us pray that Yeison would accept Jesus as his Savior. School is a big change for a little boy who has had few rules and restraints in his life and has used acting out as a means of getting attention. We are also looking for someone to sponsor Yeison for this upcoming school year. Just \$20 a month (\$180) would provide his transportation cost for the entire year.
