CHRIST IS RISEN! HE IS RISEN INDEED!

Dear Friends and Loved Ones,

"FEAR NOT, for He is risen, as He said!" (Matt.28:5-6). The apostles made the resurrection victory of Jesus the leading point of their preaching. The announcement that Christ conquered death is the central point of the gospel message proclaimed in the book of Acts. They believed in Jesus' resurrection so firmly that they were willing to give their lives for that conviction. The Apostle Paul clearly made the resurrection the basis for his teachings on how we should live the Christian life.

Perhaps the greatest significance of the resurrection is

found in the words, "As He said." The resurrection is the greatest proof of the validity of both the Old and New Testaments. God always keeps His word. As H. Robb French wrote many years ago, "God's truth will endure; our foundation is sure; there's no need for a fear or care." His Word is authenticated in human history in such miraculous ways that everyone who studies the Scriptures with an open mind comes to the conclusion that God has been in control. Because of Jesus' victory over death and hell, we can be very sure He will help us overcome all our fears as well.
