It was a blessing to see the precious preschool children again. They grew so much while I was gone. I enjoyed being with them through the second half of the 2024 school year.

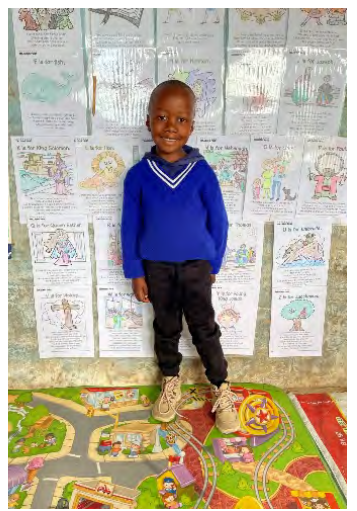

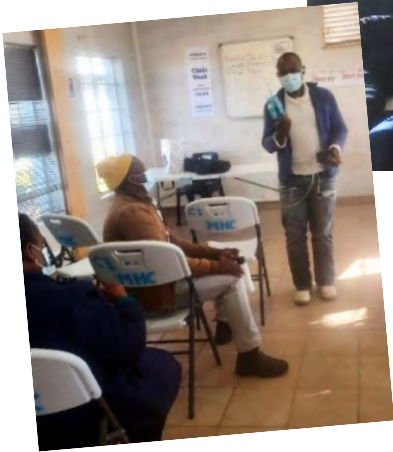

Everyone enjoyed the food and the special gifts they received.

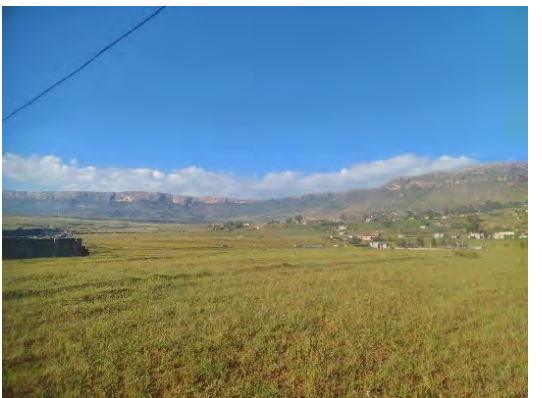
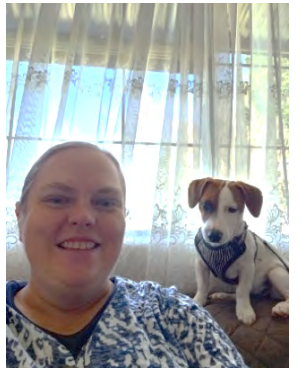
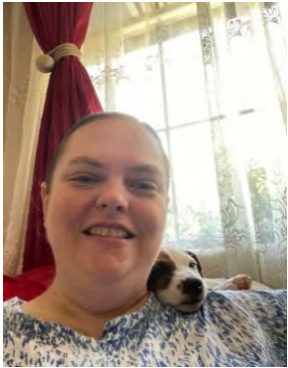
