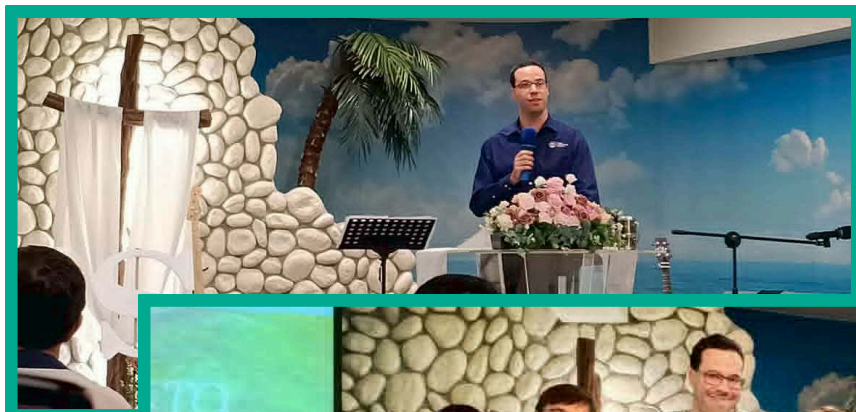
Hello, friends,

They also invited me to teach the material in their Bible study.
